Project Scope:

Neal Prince & Partners was guided by the Building Board of the Parish of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton to provide a contemporary interpretation of a traditional Catholic worship space. NPP responded with a 10,000 sq. ft. “cross nave” plan, that included narthex, children’s chapel, a guest room for visiting bishops, toilet facilities, and seating for up to 600 parishioners. The nave is constructed beneath a seventeen foot diameter barrel vault, lit by dimmer controlled indirect lighting. The vault terminates in one of two rosette windows featuring Latin Cross symbolism detailed throughout building components such as pew ends, door pulls, steeple base and entry courtyard paving. Three colors of split face masonry were employed in bands and striker courses to add interest and detail to the exterior surfaces. A translucent glass steeple mounted over the entry narthex and lit from the interior, forms a beacon of light calling local parishioners to worship at evening mass.
